#### • **Qualifications:**

- Contestants must be 19 years of age or older with a valid I.D.
- Must be able to travel and be in attendance to monthly Pride on the Plains events/benefits. Failure to attend monthly pride events will result in your title being revoked and the runner-up crowned.
- Anyone female presenting may compete for the title of Miss Pride on the Plains.
- Anyone male presenting may compete for the title of Mr Pride on the Plains.
- Anyone non-binary/transgender/genderfluid/genderqueer may compete for the title of Mx Pride on the Plains.
- Anyone who has never before held a title for a Pride Organization, Mardi Gras Crewe, or a National Pageant System may compete for the title of Newcomer.

## • Registration: (not judged)

- Early sign up will be from January 4, 2024 February 9, 2024.

- \$30 Early Bird Registration fee runs through February 9th.
- \$50 registration after and on the day of the pageant. All packets will be due no later than 5pm the night of the pageant.
- All payments can be made via website store or cash the night of the pageant.
- You will draw contestant numbers at this segment.

#### • Interview: 60 Points

- Interview will start at 4pm on the dot.
- We will start with contestant #1in the Mr category, and continue from there.
- You will be interviewed by the Executive Board of Pride on The Plains.
- Think of this like a job interview. We will ask questions about you, community, social issues, and a few more topics.
- You will be judged on:
  - Appearance
  - Ability to answer questions
  - Content of answer
  - Poise
- You may interview in drag or out of drag, completely your choice.
- 5 Points will be deducted for tardiness.

#### • Presentation: 60 Points

- Show your Pride
- 5-minute time limit for this segment.
- The contestant must provide an introduction speech during this segment.
- Contestants will be judged on their costume by:
  - Creativity
  - Fit of outfit
  - Ability to model
  - Speech and articulation
  - Music selection in relation to presentation
  - Overall effectiveness of presentation and introduction

# • THIS IS NOT TALENT

• The dressing room is **OFF LIMITS** to everybody besides the following: Contestants, Dressers, Pride on the Plains Board members, or pageant/bar staff. If

any friends, family, acquaintances of a contestant are found in the dressing room that contestant will be deducted 10 points from this segment.

# • Evening Wear: 100 Points

- 5 min time limit for this segment.
- Contestants must present evening wear for your division.
  - Miss: Floor Length evening gown/ Creative Gown is acceptable
  - Mr: Tuxedo/ Creative Tux is acceptable
  - Mx: Your interpretation of "formal evening wear" (please message Colana if you have questions)
- The song will be provided for this segment.
- Formal wear selection are judged on:
  - o Fit
  - Hair & Makeup
  - Accessories
  - o Poise
  - Modeling ability
  - Overall appearance

#### • Ouestion and Answer: 50 Points

- This segment takes place *during* the evening wear category.
- The contestant will take an envelope holding a question from one of our hosts.
- The contestant will have time to read the question to themselves.
- The question will then be announced to the judges and audience, then the contestant will have their own microphone and time to respond.
- Q&A section are judged on:
  - Answer Content
  - Ability to Communicate
  - o Poise
  - Self Confidence

#### • Talent: 100 Points

- You will have a 7 Minute time limit for this segment, with 3 additional minutes to set up and take down if needed.
- There will be a 5 point deduction for time infractions.
- You will provide music for this segment via email or USB in MP3 format. We are not responsible for any music not working.
- All music can be emailed to the DJ (music@prideontheplains.com) ahead of time. Tracks must be labeled correctly *Label example*: "Colana Bleu Talent Music"
- Contestants may **NOT** leave the stage area and go out into the crowd. *Backstage* is part of the stage area.
- Any type of legal talent is acceptable except those that may cause injury to themselves, the audience, or damage to the facility..
- Contestants will be judged on:
  - o Talent Ability (lip-sync, dance, live vocal, instrument, monologue, etc)
  - o Entertainment Value
  - Costuming and Makeup

- Sound Quality
- o Effectiveness of Props and dancers, if used.
- You will be allowed 1 dresser in the dressing room. If you have backup dancers, they will be allowed in the dressing room at the end of the Evening wear segment.
  If 2 or more dressers are found in the dressing room, you will be deducted 10 points from this segment.
- <u>Use of flames, glitter, confetti, or any other materials that will create a mess will</u> result in immediate disqualification, unless prior approval has been given.

# **Requirements for Title Holders**

- Upon winning the title you agree to the following terms:
- Title holders <u>must</u> be present at a minimum of 1 pride event per month. (Meetings are events)
- Title holders are **required** to raise a total of \$500 for Pride on The Plains by the end of their reign.
- Title holders are **required** to promote <u>all</u> Pride on The Plains events.
- Title holders are **required** to attend the pageant give-up and crown the new title holders.
- Title holders are **required** to perform at PrideFest and participate in the Pride Parade.
- In the event the title holder is not able to perform any of the duties above, they will be stripped of their title and the title will be handed down to the runner-up to complete the duties.

# **Additional Rules & Regulations:**

The Pride on The Plains Pageant is gender inclusive and is open to anyone who wishes to compete under *their* definition of the art of drag.

Each contestant will be allowed one (1) dresser. The contestant's dresser will be allowed to enter the hosting establishment free of charge. (All extras for talent will be required to pay and only be allowed dressing room access during the talent portion)

Contestants are required to always conduct themselves in a professional manner. Prohibited behavior is grounds for immediate disqualification and expulsion from the hosting establishment.

Prohibited behavior includes but is not limited to:

- o The use of any illegal substances
- o Overconsumption of alcoholic beverages by a contestant, their dresser, or talent extras.
- o Underage consumption of alcoholic beverages
- o Violent or threatening language or behavior by a contestant, their dresser, or talent extras.
- o Discriminatory words, statements, actions, or other behavior which violate the mission, vision, and values of Pride on the Plains by a contestant, their dresser, or talent extras.
- o Theft of, or intentional damage or destruction to real and personal property by a contestant, their dresser, talent extras, or the facility.

# **Newcomer Category Information:**
